

NOVA SCOTIA and PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND TOUR
September 11-22, 2018

Day 1 Sept 11

Leave Ephrata at 7am and drive to Hartford Conn. Lunch at Old Country Buffet. Sleep just south of Bangor Maine.

Day 2-Sept 12

Leave motel at 7am. Meet a step on guide and drive though Acadia National Park, one of the most beautiful and enchanting natural places on the North American. See Thunder Hole and experience the thunder of the sea against the rocky shores of Maine! - Have lunch on your own in Bar Harbor. At 1 pm half of the group will board the Lulu Lobster Boat for a 2 hr. tour. Learn and see how Lobstering is done, see sea otters and more. While the other half have free time in Bar Harbor. At 3 pm the other half will go on the tour. We will return to the same motel and get supper nearby at a restaurant of your choice.

Day 3-Sept 13

Leave motel at 7 am cross the border, move our clock ahead 1 hr. You will need your birth certificate or passport Stop at St John for lunch and see the reversing Falls. Sleep in Moncton

Day 4 Sept 14

Today we will visit Hopewell Cape. If it is low tide we will walk on the river floor. We will have lunch there before leaving. And hopefully be able to see it at high tide Sleep at Halifax

Day 5 - Sept 15

Today we see Peggy's cove and watch the wave's crash against the rocky shore. And the quaint village of Peggy's Cove. Lunch is on your own. After lunch we'll head to visit Halifax Hoppers (a ride around downtown with some history thrown in, and then a splash into the Halifax Harbor for some great views of the Halifax waterfront. Day 9- Sept 19

Tour the Bottle House made with 25,000 recycled bottles. West Point Lighthouse, Ann of Green Gables, located in Cavendish, the site which inspired the setting for L.M. Montgomery to create her beloved tale of a red-haired orphan, Anne of Green Gables. Supper will be at New Glasgow Lobster House (also have Steak). Cross over the Confederation Bridge and sleep in Moncton NB.

Day 10- Sept 20

Stop at the Hartland Covered Bridge. The world's longest covered bridge. Cross the border into the U.S. Have your Passports or Birth certificate with you. Sleep in N. Conway New Hampshire

Day 11 - Sept 21

Get an early start and head for MT Washington NH. And ride to the top of Mt. Washington on the world's first mountain-climbing cog railway. Supper on a River Boat, at Lake George NY 250 MILES

Documents Required to Cross the US-Canadian Border

The only acceptable documents to cross the US-Canadian border by land or sea are:

US Citizens 16 and over

- United States Passport, or
- United States Passport Card, or
- Trusted Traveler Card (NEXUS, FAST or SENTRI), or
- Enhanced Driver's License, Enhanced Learner's Permit, or Enhanced State ID card, or
- Amish and Mennonite Old Order only:
- birth certificate, (with raised seal) and- signed copy of IRS form 4029, application for exemption from Social Security
